# MACKENZIE CORPORATE BOND FUND

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## Management Discussion of Fund Performance

June 4, 2024

This Management Discussion of Fund Performance presents the portfolio management team's view on the significant factors and developments that have affected the Fund's performance and outlook in the year ended March 31, 2024 (the "period"). If the Fund was established during the period, "period" represents the period since inception.

In this report, "Mackenzie" and "the Manager" refer to Mackenzie Financial Corporation, the manager of the Fund. In addition, net asset value ("NAV") refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

### Investment Objective and Strategies

The Fund seeks above-average income with potential for long-term capital growth by investing primarily in higher-yielding Canadian fixed income securities and equities. It may hold up to 49% of its assets in foreign investments.

### Risk

The risks of the Fund remain as discussed in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus.

The Fund is suitable for short- to medium-term investors looking for a Canadian fixed income fund to hold as part of their portfolio, who can handle the volatility of bond markets and who have a low to medium tolerance for risk.

### Results of Operations

#### Investment Performance

The performance of all series in the current and previous periods is shown in the *Past Performance* section of the report. Performance will vary by series primarily because fees and expenses differ between series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. Please refer to the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of this report for the varying management and administration fees payable by each series. The following comparison to market indices is intended to help investors understand the Fund's performance relative to the general performance of the markets. However, the Fund's mandate may be different from that of the indices shown.

During the period, the Fund's Series A securities returned 7.3%, and Series LB securities returned 7.2% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the series). This compares with a return of 2.1% for the Fund's broad-based index, the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index, and a return of 10.1% for a blended index composed of a 50% weighting in the ICE BofA High Yield Canadian Issuers (Hedged) Index (returned 10.1%) and a 50% weighting in the ICE BofA US High Yield (Hedged) Index (returned 10.1%). All index and series returns are calculated on a total return basis in Canadian dollar terms. Investors cannot invest in an index without incurring fees, expenses and commissions, which are not reflected in the index returns.

The Bank of Canada paused interest rate increases in the period, holding its policy rate at 5.00% after two 25-basis-point rises. Treasury yields reached peak levels and then fell in response to the policy shift. Inflation slowed significantly, and wage growth moderated but remained around 5%. The Bank of Canada continued to express concerns about inflation but signalled the possibility of a policy rate cut later in 2024. Prices of high-yield bonds rose, and spreads (the difference in yield between high-yield and investment grade bonds) narrowed.

The Fund outperformed the broad-based index because of its focus on high-yield bonds, which outperformed the broader fixed income market in the period. Given the Fund's mandate, the return of the blended index is a more meaningful comparison.

The Fund underperformed the blended index, with holdings in corporate bonds in the industrial and financial sectors detracting from performance.

Conversely, holdings in term loans contributed to performance, as did the Fund's currency management.

Over the period, neither portfolio activity nor market developments significantly changed the positioning of the Fund.

### Environmental, Social and Governance ("ESG") Integration

The Fund added a new position in a bond issued by Kruger Products LP (6.00%, 04-24-2025), a paper company the portfolio management team considers to be best-in-class on ESG characteristics. Kruger is Canada's largest manufacturer of tissue products. All its fibre comes from third-party certified sustainable forests, and Kruger was the first Canadian tissue manufacturer to earn Forest Stewardship Council certification (in 2011). The company's 2030 sustainability targets include reducing scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas emissions by 35% (from 2015 base year), reducing water consumption by 35% (from 2015 base year) and reducing virgin plastic packaging in branded products by 50% (from 2020 base year). (The Greenhouse Gas Protocol defines scope 1 as direct emissions from fuel burned in a company's owned or controlled assets and/or chemical leaks and spills, and scope 2 as indirect emissions from purchased electricity, cooling, heat and/or steam.)

### Net Assets

The Fund's net assets decreased by 3.0% during the period to \$331.6 million. This change was composed primarily of \$24.5 million in net income (including any interest and/or dividend income) from investment performance, after deducting fees and expenses, and a decrease of \$34.8 million due to net securityholder activity (including sales, redemptions and cash distributions).

### Fees and Expenses

The management expense ratio ("MER") for each series during the year ended March 31, 2024, was generally similar to the MER for the year ended March 31, 2023. Total expenses paid vary from period to period mainly as a result of changes in average assets in each series. The MERs for all series are presented in the *Financial Highlights* section of this report.

### Recent Developments

The portfolio management team believes that robust economic data and elevated inflation at period-end have diminished earlier market expectations for policy easing by the U.S. Federal Reserve. The team expects the Federal Reserve to decrease the federal funds rate in 2024, but more slowly than many had anticipated, given concerns that inflation could rise.

The team is cautious about high-yield bonds and term loans as economic uncertainty challenges credit fundamentals amid tighter spreads (the difference in yield between high-yield and investment grade bonds). The team believes issuer selection and sound credit research remain important in assessing investment opportunities.

### Related Party Transactions

#### Management and Administration Services

For each applicable series, the Fund paid management fees and administration fees to the Manager at the annual rates specified under *Fund Formation and Series Information* in this report and as more fully described in the Prospectus. In return for the administration fees, the Manager pays all costs and expenses (other than certain specified fund costs) required to operate the Fund that are not included in management fees. See also *Management Fees*.

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## Other Related Party Transactions

At March 31, 2024, the Fund held an investment of \$4.7 million (1.4% of the Fund's NAV) in Northleaf Private Credit II LP, a private fund managed by Northleaf Capital Partners, a company affiliated with the Manager. This represents US\$3.6 million as part of a total commitment to invest US\$4.4 million. In making the investment, the Manager relied on a positive recommendation previously issued by the Mackenzie Funds' Independent Review Committee.

At March 31, 2024, the Fund held an investment of \$2.4 million (0.7% of the Fund's NAV) in Sagard Credit Partners II, LP, a private fund managed by Sagard Holdings Inc., a company affiliated with the Manager. This represents US\$1.6 million as part of a total commitment to invest US\$4.4 million. In making the investment, the Manager relied on a positive recommendation previously issued by the Mackenzie Funds' Independent Review Committee.

Investment funds managed by Mackenzie and its affiliates may invest in the Fund. All these investments are made on a prospectus-exempt basis in accordance with the investment objectives of those funds. At March 31, 2024, funds managed by Mackenzie owned 0.7% of the Fund's NAV, and funds managed by The Canada Life Assurance Company and Canada Life Investment Management Ltd. owned 7.0% of the Fund's NAV. All related party transactions are based on the NAV per security on each transaction day. As a result of these investments, the Fund may be subject to large transaction risk as discussed in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus. Mackenzie manages this risk to reduce the possibility of any adverse effect on the Fund or on its investors, through such processes as requiring advance notice of large redemptions.

During the period, the Fund received \$0.01 million in income distributions from investments in exchange-traded funds ("ETFs") managed by Mackenzie to offset fees paid within those ETFs. There is no assurance that these distributions will continue in the future.

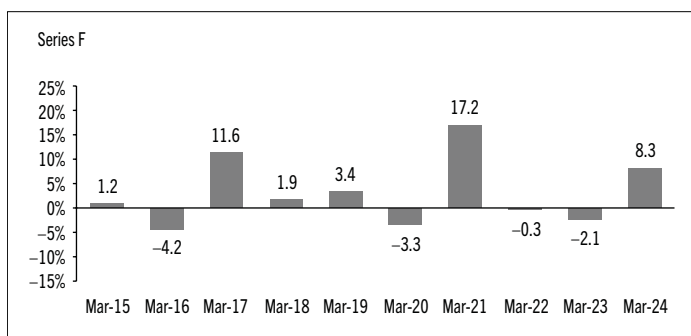
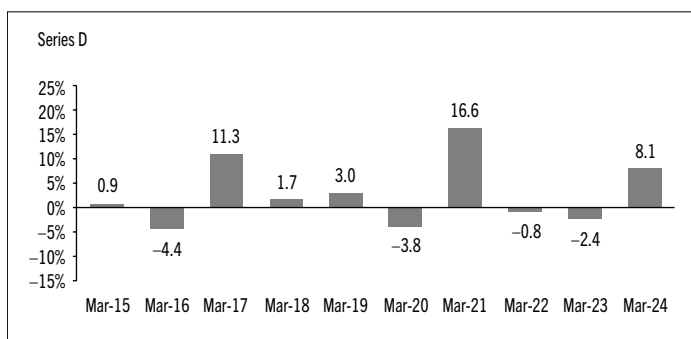
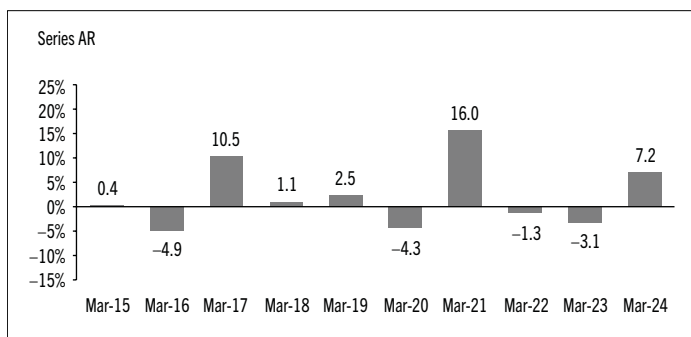
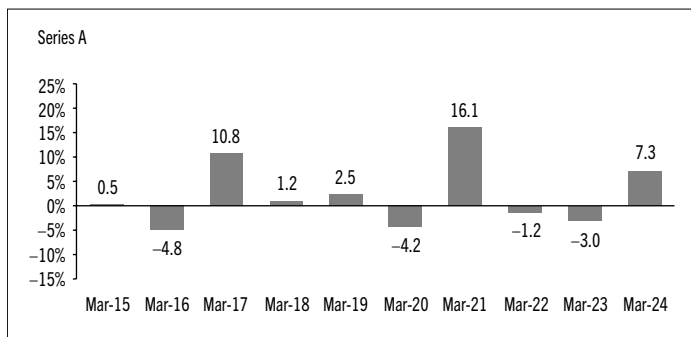
## Past Performance

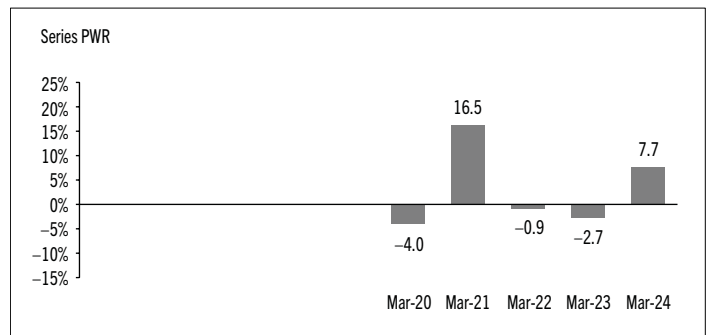
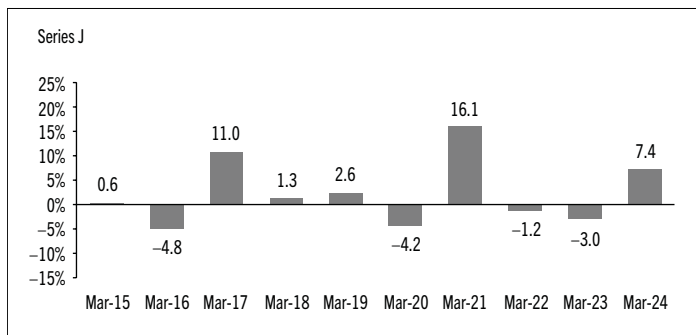
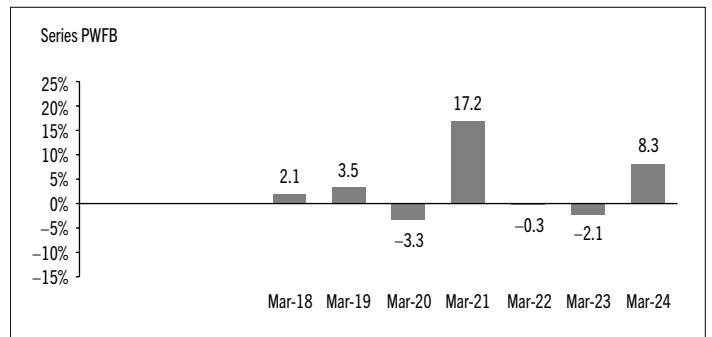
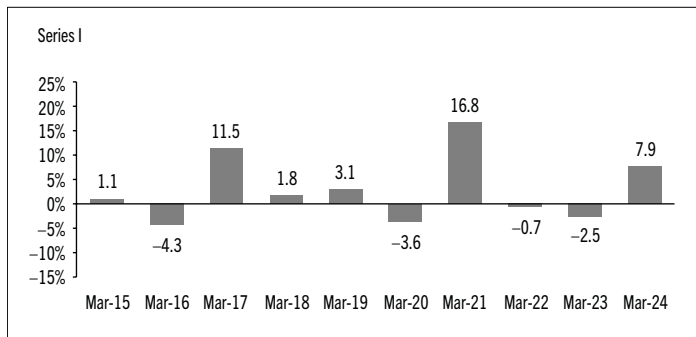
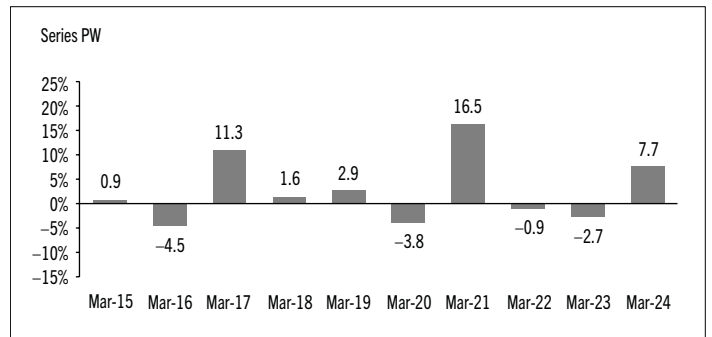
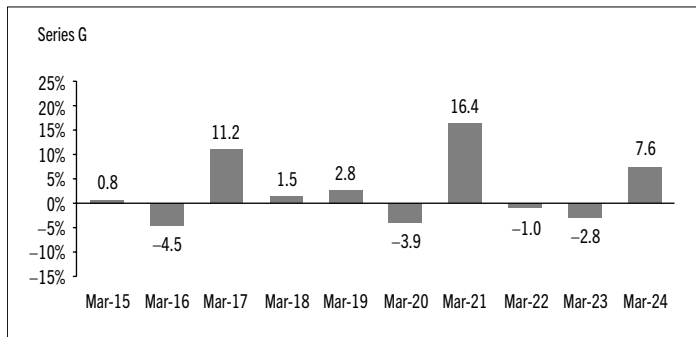
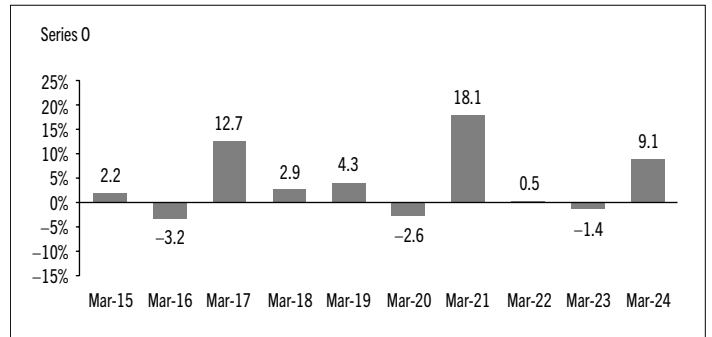
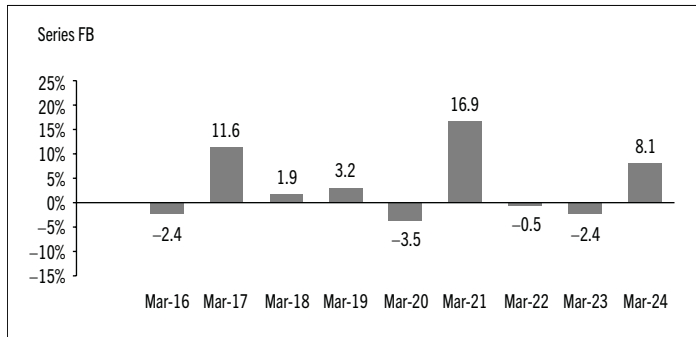
## Year-by-Year Returns

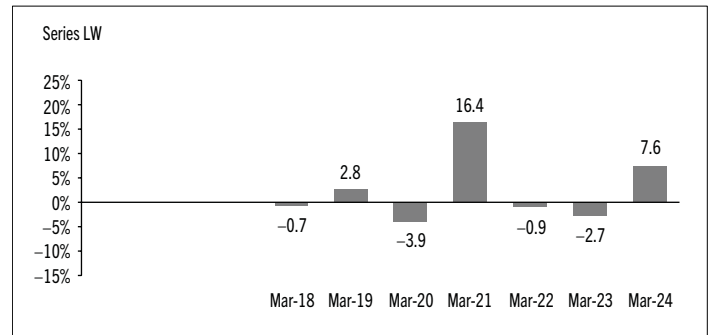
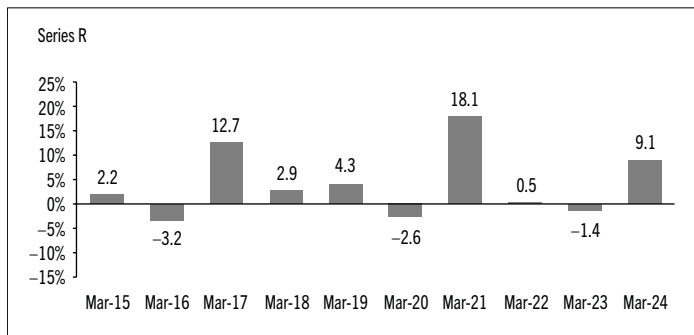
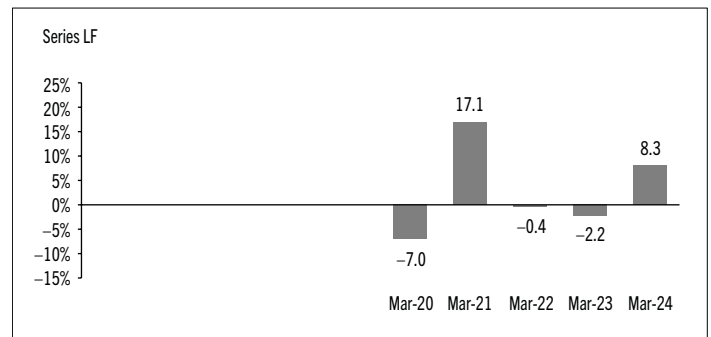
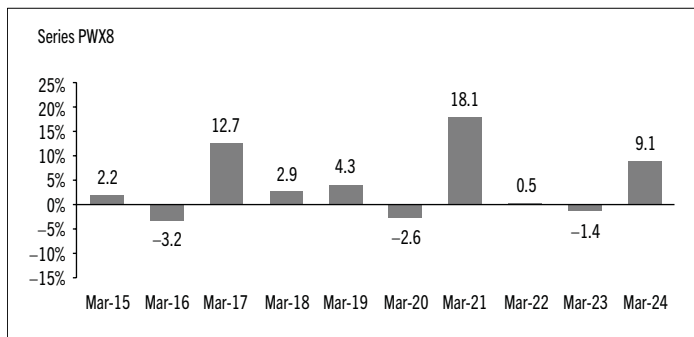
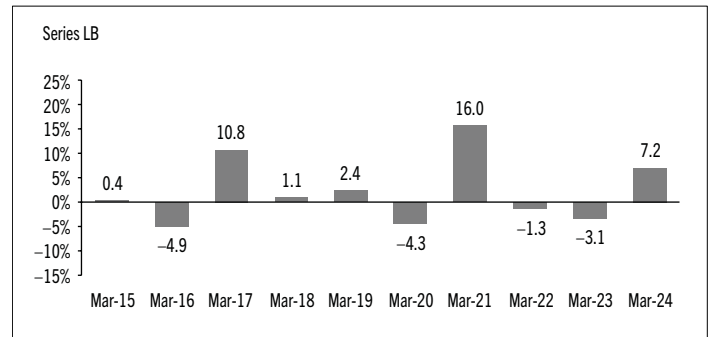
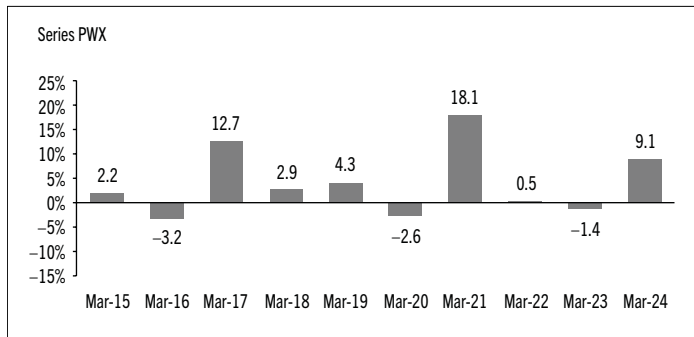
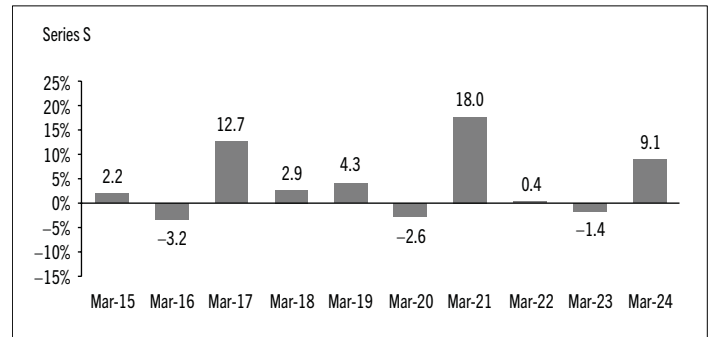
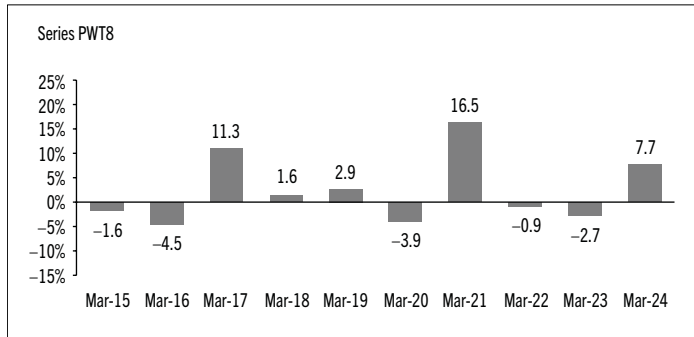
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## Annual Compound Returns

The FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index is a broad measure of Canadian bonds with terms to maturity of more than one year. It includes federal, provincial, municipal and corporate bonds rated "BBB" or higher.

The ICE BofA High Yield Canadian Issuers (Hedged) Index tracks the performance of non-investment grade debt publicly issued by Canadian corporations. Qualifying bonds must have a remaining term to maturity of at least one year, a fixed coupon schedule and a minimum outstanding amount of C\$100 million. The foreign currency exposure is hedged to the Canadian dollar.

The ICE BofA US High Yield (Hedged) Index tracks the performance of non-investment grade U.S. dollar-denominated corporate bonds publicly issued in the U.S. market. Qualifying bonds must have a remaining term to maturity of at least one year, a fixed coupon schedule and a minimum outstanding amount of US\$100 million. The foreign currency exposure is hedged to the Canadian dollar.

## Management Fees

The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by the Manager to pay for the costs of managing the investment portfolio of the Fund and/or the underlying fund(s), as applicable, including providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio, and providing other services. The Manager also used the management fees to fund sales commissions, trailing commissions and any other compensation (collectively "distribution-related payments") to registered dealers and brokers whose clients invest in the Fund.

LBC Financial Services Inc. ("LBC") is the principal distributor for the LBC series securities of the Fund (as listed under *Fund Formation and Series Information*) and receives a portion of the management fees that the Fund pays to the Manager. Under this arrangement, LBC was entitled to approximately 25% of the total management fees that the Manager received from the LBC series of all Mackenzie funds during the period. The Manager is responsible for paying all distribution-related payments to LBC-authorized dealers whose clients invest in the LBC series of the Fund.

The following dealers affiliated with the Manager may be entitled to distribution-related payments from the Manager on the same basis as unrelated registered brokers and dealers: Investors Group Securities Inc. and Investors Group Financial Services Inc.

The Manager used approximately 42% of the total management fee revenues received from all Mackenzie funds during the period to fund distribution-related payments to registered dealers and brokers. In comparison, such distribution-related payments for the Fund represented on average 31% of the management fees paid by all applicable series of the Fund during the period. The actual percentage for each series may be higher or lower than the average depending on the level of trailing commissions and sales commissions paid for that series.
